Facilitating Advance Care Planning: An Interprofessional Educational Program

Curriculum Materials

This multifaceted Interprofessional education module has been developed on advanced care planning. The module is intended for formal caregivers and undergraduate and postgraduate students in the health professions. It has been produced in an Interprofessional approach for an audience which includes health care professionals such as physicians, nurses, social workers, spiritual advisors, and trained volunteers for palliative care services.

Topics discussed within this module include the importance of advance care planning, issues on the incapacity to give informed consent, the decision making process for end-of-life care, communication of end of life conditions and risks/benefits of possible treatment, appointment of a substitute decision-maker and appropriate models of advance care planning.
