Anatomy/Cell Sciences includes: neurobiology (Dalhousie University); physiological sciences (University of British Columbia).

Biochemistry includes: molecular biology (Dalhousie University); medical genetics (University of Manitoba); molecular biology (University of Calgary); molecular biology (University of British Columbia).

Medical Biology includes molecular biology, medical biochemistry, pathology (Université Laval).

Microbiology/Immunology: faculty appointed to primarily basic science departments are classified under "microbiology/immunology"; faculty appointed to clinical allergy and immunology departments are classified under "Medicine-allergy & clinical immunology"; medical microbiology is classified under "infectious diseases".

Physiology includes: biophysics (Dalhousie University), biophysics (Université de Sherbrooke); pharmacology (University of Western Ontario); pharmacology (University of Calgary).

Other miscellaneous basic sciences includes: molecular biology, neurosciences (Memorial University of Nfld); neurosciences (McGill University); Donnelly Centre for Cellular & Biomolecular Research (University of Toronto); clinical chemistry, molecular biology, neurosciences (Northern Ontario School of Medicine); neurosciences (University of Alberta).

Anaesthesiology includes pharmacology & therapeutics (University of British Columbia).

Internal Medicine: the figures reported may include some subspecialists; Université Laval, University of Toronto, University of Western Ontario, University of Alberta, University of Calgary and University of British Columbia included many subspecialists in internal medicine.

Radiation Oncology includes nuclear medicine (Université de Sherbrooke).

Radiology/Diagnostic Radiology may include medical imaging, nuclear medicine and radiation oncology because some faculties do not give a breakdown among these fields.

Surgery - General & Other: includes paediatric surgery (Queen's University); the figures reported may include some subspecialists; Université Laval, University of Toronto, University of Western Ontario, University of Alberta, University of Calgary and University of British Columbia included many surgical subspecialists in this category.

Public Health & related includes biostatistics; clinical epidemiology; community health; environmental health; epidemiology; health administration; health information (Northern Ontario School of Medicine); health policy, management & evaluation; occupational health; preventive medicine; social medicine.

Other miscellaneous fields includes: administration, deans' offices, information technology and libraries. For the Northern Ontario School of Medicine this also includes 107 part-time faculty members reported as "Clinical Education" which represents other allied health professions involved in teaching medical students.
