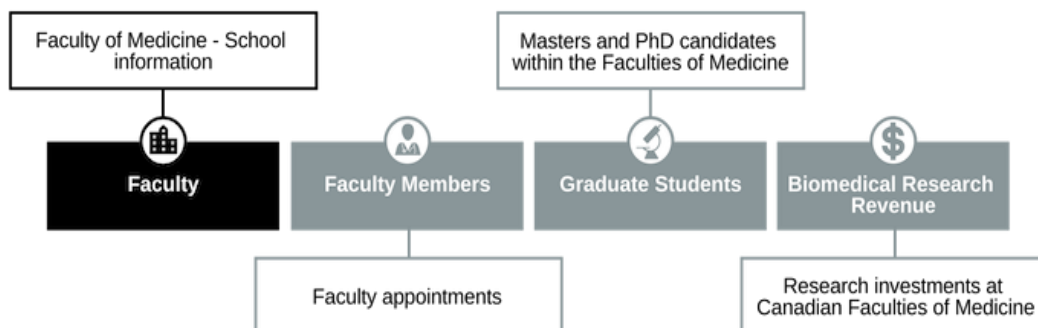


## Canadian Medical Education Statistics 2022

### Section A. AFMC Faculties of Medicine Data – Description:

#### AFMC Data Holdings - *Faculties of Medicine of Canada*



Section A contains information about the seventeen Canadian Faculties of Medicine. This section provides information on quotas for first year positions, duration of clinical clerkships and stipend amounts, tuition and other fees, post-M.D. trainee fees and remuneration, and other information about the Faculties of Medicine. The data are collected primarily via the AFMC Faculty of Medicine Survey (AFMS), which is an annual two-part survey collecting statistical information about Canadian faculties of medicine on a number of topics. The AFMS data have been published annually in the CMES collection since 1978, with graduate student and faculty data available in our database since 2001 and all data since 2012.
